

Carl Brazley



Carl Brazley is a veteran of the Canadian Football League. He played defensive back for 13 years for the Montreal Alouettes, Ottawa Rough Riders and Toronto Argonauts. He was a CFL All-Star in 1983, the same season he won the Grey Cup with the Argos. In that Grey Cup game, Carl was named the Defensive MVP of the championship game.

Carl debuted in the CFL with the Montreal Alouettes in 1980 playing just 3 games in his rookie season. In 1982, after being claimed by the Ottawa Rough Riders, he broke through with 4 interceptions and was named an Eastern Division All Star. In 1983, Carl signed with the Buffalo bills but returned to the CFL in September to play for the Toronto Argonauts. That season, he garnered another East All Star honor and his first CFL All Star selection. He was named an Eastern All Star the following three seasons as well. In 1987, he went back to the NFL to play for the San Diego Chargers and returned to the Argos once again in 1988 where he stayed until retirement after the 1992 season.

Brazley finished his CFL career with 43 interceptions and 18 fumble recoveries. Besides playing defensive back, Carl was also used on kick-off and punt returns and his highlight in this regard was his 1990 return of a missed field goal 108 yards for a touchdown. Carl, always a smart businessman, is President and CEO of his own marketing firm. He also serves on several boards that serve the advancement of local youth in Kentucky, small and minority businesses, and education and charitable outreach.
