



Greg Pryor

Greg is a World Series Champion having played for the 1985 Kansas City Royals. He was a third baseman, second baseman and shortstop in his ten seasons played in the major leagues. Of course, you don't play a lot of third base for the Royals when George Brett is on the team!

Greg was drafted by the Washington Senators in 1971 and worked his way through the minors to the majors by 1976; the team by then had moved to Texas to become Rangers. In 1978 he signed as a free agent with the Chicago White Sox and took his middle infielder talents to the Windy City for the next four seasons. The club named Greg their team's Rookie of the Year in 1978. He became a starter in 1979 and rewarded his manager with a .275 average, his highest average for a single season in his career.

Pryor was traded to the Kansas City Royals for the 1982 seasons and it was here that he played the next 5 seasons until he retired after the 1986 season. In KC, he would find himself playing any of the four infield positions.

Greg is the answer to an obscure trivia question: Only one player played in both the "Disco Demolition game in Chicago in 1979 and in the Infamous George Brett Pine Tar game in 1982.
