He began his NHL career in 1986 with the St. Louis Blues after being their first round draft choice. But as the on-ice free spirit he was, coach Pat Burns had him spend much of his time in the minors. He was traded to the Chicago Blackhawks part way through the 1989-90 season and spent his most successful time in the Windy City for all or parts of 5 seasons.

Jocelyn then spent the next 5 seasons between the Hartford Whalers, New Jersey Devils, Calgary Flames and Phoenix Coyotes.
