



Lee Tunnell

Lee pitched for 6 Major League seasons from 1982 To 1989. And he also spent 3 seasons pitching in Japan from 1991 to 1993. He began his career with the Pittsburgh Pirates for whom he pitched for 4 seasons. He posted a career-high 11 wins for the Pirates in 1983 and got some votes for Rookie of the Year.

The St. Louis Cardinals purchased Lee's contract and in 1987, he had the honor of playing in the World Series when he posted a 2.08 ERA in 2 appearances. He then made a one-season stop in the American League with the Minnesota Twins before heading across the pond to Japan.

On his return to North America, Lee was a pitching coach for several minor leagues teams and made his return to the majors with the Cincinnati Reds as their bullpen coach in 2006. Tunnell became the bullpen coach of the Milwaukee Brewers in 2012.

Tunnell accepted Christ as his Saviour as a young boy of 10 years old. He and some friends had stolen some soda pop from a baseball park concession stand. When his father found out, he sat young Lee down and explained several key truths about the Bible and salvation to his son. A short time later, Lee prayed to invite Christ into his heart and accepted God's gift of eternal life.
