



## Marv Edwards

Here's some trivia for you – only 4 players in NHL have had the surname Edwards and all four were goaltenders – Marv, Gary, Roy and Don.

Marv took the long road to the NHL, making his debut in 1969 as the oldest rookie in the history of the NHL. Marv played a single game for the Pittsburgh Penguins that season. He was claimed by the Toronto Maple Leafs the following season where he played in 25 games. It was back to the minors for Marv but he resurfaced again with the California Golden Seals in 1972 where he spent the final two seasons of his career before retiring at age 39.

Marv played goal in 61 career games winning 15 of them and recording two



shutouts. While others may think

his record is lacking, this was a great reward for a player who spent from 1954 to 1968 buried in the minor leagues.
