



Meghan Agosta

Meghan Agosta is a force to be reckoned with, both on the ice as one of the world's best women's hockey players of all time and as a constable on the Vancouver Police Department.

Meghan joined the Canadian National Women's Team at the tender age of 17 in 2004. Since that time, she has participated in four Olympic Games - 2006 in Turin, 2010 in Vancouver, 2014 in Sochi and 2018 in Pyeongchang. She has captured 3 Olympic gold medals and 1 silver medal. In 2010, Meghan was the top scorer in the Olympics with 9 goals and 6 assists for 15 points in 5 games played.



She was named Most Valuable Player and Best Forward along with being named to the Media All-Star Team. Agosta has also been a top Canadian player in World Championships, having played in eight tournaments and coming away with 2 gold and 6 silver medals.

In her collegiate career with Mercyhurst University, Meghan was named as a 4-time finalist for the Patty Kazmaier Award given to the NCAA's top women's player. She also spent 2 seasons in the Canadian Women's Hockey League and won the scoring title both seasons, the only player to ever do win the title in consecutive seasons. In 2010-2011, she set the single season scoring record with 85 points on 38 goals and 47 assists in only 34 games; the following season she followed up with 80 points in only 27 games.

Following the Sochi Olympics, Agosta took time off from hockey to focus on her policing career. As a Mercyhurst graduate with a degree in Criminal Justice Law



Enforcement and a minor in Criminalistics Psychology, she joined the Vancouver Police Department as a probationary constable in 2014. In 2015, she graduated from the VPD Academy and became a sworn member of the force where she now serves her community.
