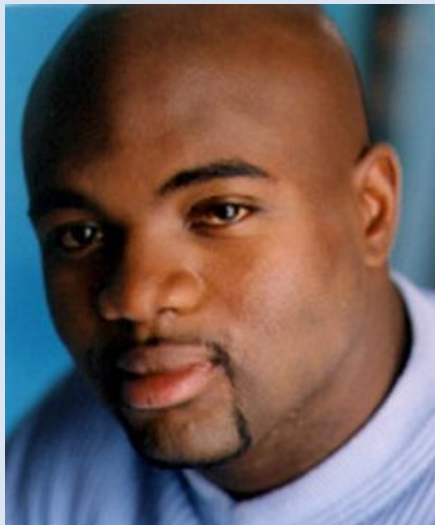




Orlando Bowen
