



## Steve Trout

Steve “Rainbow” Trout pitched in the Major Leagues from 1978 to 1989. Steve is the son of another great pitcher, “Dizzy” Trout who pitched some fantastic seasons for the Detroit Tigers from 1940 to 1953. But Steve was a little “dizzy” himself. In mid-1987, the New York Yankees traded for Steve but then sent him on to the Seattle Mariners at the end of that season. Steve then finished his career in Seattle in 1989.

Steve has left much of his carefree ways behind him and now runs baseball camps in Florida much of the year. In fact, he has a baseball field on his property from which to teach the fine points of the game.
